- Position reports to the THSRC Dive Board Representative.
- Develop & implement dive program to include but not limited to:
 - Technique instruction & development.
 - Evaluate and offer suggestions for improvement to team members.
 - Develop regimen, manage and participate fully in practices and clinics.
 - Prepare for, attend, manage and participate fully in all meets and championships.
 - Learn E-Dive competition software.
 - Prepare and enter line-ups for meets through use of computer software.
 - Attend league coaches meetings, team sign up day, parents meetings and end of the season banquet.
- Focus on safety, individual participation, and teaching to create better divers.
- Strive to make the team enjoyable and competitive for all participants.
- Promote team spirit.
- Arrive before clinics, practices, and meet warm ups to be prepared for event adequately.
- Stay at practice, clinics or meets for entire duration or as required by the event.
- Direct, develop and manage assistant coaches where applicable.
- Work with Dive Parent Coordinators to run program, staff events and meets.
- Maintain a positive working relationship with club management and staff, THSRC Board members, and other teams/coaches of the league.
- Any absence or request to be late or leave early from clinics, practices, meets and events must be pre-approved by Dive Coordinator.
- Be professional in your conduct, as you represent THSRC.
- Communicate open and freely.
- Complete employment information as required by THSRC to process payroll and meet staff policies.
- Obey all THSRC rules, policies, and regulations and all league rules and policies.
